#### **Tools:**

Paint bucket, stirring rod, metal container if required

### **Preparation:**

Min. processing temperature 18°C.

# **Application:**

- Pour approx. half of the 2.5 l of oil into a paint bucket. Shake l can of Faxe Combicolor vigorously and pour the complete contents into the paint bucket. Mix thoroughly using the mixing rod. Pour the remaining oil into the bucket, whilst stirring continuously.
- The oil is now ready for use and can be applied in the same way as described for oil.

### Aftercare:

Refer to the label on the product, with which the Combicolor was mixed. Lye colored with Combicolor does not contain a binding agent. The surface of wood treated with this must be oiled, waxed or sealed.
